Since 2018 I am head of the **Master in Socio-Economics at FAU Erlangen-Nürnberg** and have pushed the implementation of the new areas of specializations “Data Science” and “Sustainability”. Before leaving the University of Mannheim, I also participated in writing a successful proposal for the new interdisciplinary **“Mannheim Master in Data Science”** which combines perspectives from computer science, statistics, and the social sciences and aims to enable students to exploit the potentials of big data and recent computational advances.
